Happy Lent! (What? Really?)



ES. REALLY!

Originally Lent was three days long and came immediately before Easter. Everyone thought it was wonderful to spend those three days reflecting on their own sinfulness and being thankful for how much God had done for them. Eventually, they thought that if three days was wonderful, five or seven days would be better. Then It expanded to a couple of weeks and eventually to 7 weeks. That is like saying "

If two scoops of sugar is great in coffee, then five scoops would be better and 20 scoops would be even better."

If that wasn't enough, they created a second Lent before Christmas and called it Advent. Several years ago, the Lutheran Church decided it did not need 2 Lenten seasons. So, it changed the emphasis of Advent from repentance to hope and changed the color of Advent from the penitential purple to the hopeful color of blue. I applaud the church for having done this. But now I believe it would be beneficial for the church to use the same wisdom and re-think it's approach to Lent.

Ash Wednesday is awesome! It will stay exactly as it is. It is a day to remember that we are "dust and to dust we shall return." It is a day to be humbled and penitential. It is my earnest hope that 100% of our members will be able to receive ashes that day at either our 12 o'clock or our 7 o'clock worship. This year Ash Wednesday falls on February 14 which is also Valentine's Day. If you are going out in the evening to celebrate Valentine's Day, Please come to the noontime service. In the event that neither noon nor 7:00 PM is possible, we are again having drive up ashes in front of our fellowship hall from 8:00 AM - 9:30 AM. Last year it was a wonderful witness to our community and was very well received.

Now things may change a little bit at St Stephen for the middle of Lent. The focus for our Thursday mid week and our Sunday morning services will be on spiritual growth and faithful service to our Lord. The Lord has come that he might build us up. We are his beloved children. Let us be strengthened, encouraged, and built up in the faith.

Ahhh. But holy week is different. We will return to the traditions of the original length and experience. We will worship in traditional ways on Maundy Thursday and Good Friday. More about these next month.

So, happy Lent. Let us begin in humility on Ash Wednesday, and then be joyfully strengthened in our faith and our actions through our worship experiences.
