

ome of you might still be up north as vou receive this newsletter or read it in our webpage. We sincerely hope that during these months you may be enjoving family, relatives, friends and your home church family. Perhaps your case is that little by little you are spending more time down here in Florida and wish to partake of more initiatives in the life and ministry of St. Stephen.

No matter where we are, it is a joy to have a faith community where to serve, give, and receive love. Like many, you may be torn into not wanting to break ties with either of the congregations you consider your church. The good news is that you don't have to. You have a couple of options as you

may consider an associate membership.

According to our Constitution, Associate Members "are persons holding membership in other Lutheran [Christian] congregations who wish to retain such membership but desire to participate in the life and mission of this congregation" (*C8.02.). Such members may participate in all aspects of the congregation's life except voting, and are not eligible for elected offices.

Well, some of the options then are, either you keep your official membership up north but become an Associate Member at St. Stephen. Or if you think you might be spending more time here, you could do the other way around and become an official

member here and keep an associate membership up north. You decide where you will be contributing more of your skills, time and treasure.

St. Stephen is noticing a spiritual growth shown by the faithful increasing of the stewardship of its members and regular visitors, and in new people coming and staying with us. That is a great feeling!

Would you consider been an official or an associate member of St. Stephen? If so, or if you need more information, please don't hesitate in

talking to me.
