October brings with it many opportunities for ministry and mission among us!

There is a lot going on at St. Stephen this month and this brings a member of opportunities for you to invite others into the life of this community. As you can see from the graphic on the left, the single largest factor by far when

it comes to people becoming involved in a church, is that they were invited by a friend. Here is what is going on in our congregation in October. These events provide a variety of "doors" into contact with St. Stephen:

Weekly Tuesday Bible Study at 7pm. This is a perfect opportunity to bring a friend from the community to explore scripture in a causal, non-threatening atmosphere. We will study the Book of Genesis for the next couple of months. The stories of this book are known to many in the culture and yet the meaning of Creation, The Fall, Cain and Able, the Tower of Babel, and the Flood have deep meaning for our lives and world view. 
#### Saturday, October 5 – **Blessing of the Animals**
